World Communion Sunday

On October 4 we will join with Christians around the globe in celebrating World Communion Sunday. World Communion Sunday originated in Shadyside Presbyterian Church, located in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, led by the Rev. Dr. Hugh Thomson Kerr in 1933.

1933 was the darkest year of the Great Depression. The clouds of Nazism and fascism hovered over Europe and threatened the entire world.

As a faith response to these concerns, a group of leaders at Shadyside Presbyterian sought to do something both real and symbolic to proclaim that God is God indeed, in spite of politics, economics and anything the future may hold.

Rediscovering the unifying power of Christ in the Lord's Supper, they reaffirmed that in Christ all Christians are one, regardless of nationality, race or ethnicity. From their meeting came the first World Communion Sunday in 1936. In the years that followed, other denominations began to celebrate this special Sunday.

As we tire of the stress and strain of separation during pandemic times, we need to rediscover peace in the unifying power of Christ through the Lord's Supper. To that end, the Session has authorized the celebration of communion on October 4.
